



Upper Tummel Trout Fishing Directions

The Upper Tummel is the section of river that runs from Clunie Dam at Loch Tummel to Loch Faskally below.

It is a rocky river that flows through sections of overgrown and sometimes inaccessible gorge. Water carved rocks and boulders can be very dangerous and unpredictable so extreme care is required when navigating along the riverside.

Apart from the vicinity of the Jubilee Bridge near the downstream end of the beat there is no vehicular access close to the river, so you must make your way from the public road on foot.

Because of the difficult access much of the beat is unsuited for less physically fit anglers.
